

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

APRIL 2, 1993

The Board of Supervisors of Modoc County met in special session this 2nd day of April 1993. Present were Supervisors John Schreiber, Joe Colt, Ed Carver, Ron McIntyre and Nancy J. Huffman. Also present was Deputy Clerk Cindy Jackson.

Meeting called to order pursuant to law by Chairman Colt. Flag salute. Chairman notes the agenda was posted March 29, 1993.

The purpose of this meeting is for an information workshop with Assemblyman Bernie Richter and his aide, David Reade, regarding certain concerns Modoc County has with the State budget and mandates on programs.

Public Works Director Mike Maxwell discusses the Solid Waste program and the problems Modoc County is having meeting the state mandatory requirements for solid waste with regards to the solid waste budget. Mr. Maxwell reports to Assemblyman Richter the recommendations he would like to make to ease up on State mandated requirements regarding Solid Waste programs in the smaller rural areas.

John Dederick and Rick Wheat discuss the history and current status of Modoc Medical Center.

Road Commissioner John Fisher reports on the 1991 Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) and Senate Bill 1435 regarding the lack of funds to Modoc County.

Chairman Colt discusses AB-8 monies and the problems the shift will cause for Volunteer Fire Districts. Chairman Colt discusses the older equipment Modoc County fire districts have, the costs for upkeep on them and the insurance costs.
