

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

MAY 8, 1995

Special meeting of the Board called to order by Chairman McIntyre. Present: Supervisors Zandstra, Colt, Carver, McIntyre and Huffman. Director of Administrative Services Maxwell and Clerk Madison also present.

Following the flag salute the invocation is offered by Supervisor Zandstra. Chairman notes the agenda was mailed and posted May 5, 1995.

Director of Administrative Services Maxwell discusses local emergency due to rains and snow run off creating a flooding situation. The Board proclaimed the local emergency the 9th day of March, 1995, and the emergency remains in existence now. There remains in effect a Gubernatorial declaration of a state of emergency in Modoc County and the state associated with the storms.


Motion by Supervisor Huffman, seconded by Supervisor Carver and unanimously carried, to adopt Resolution No. 95-34, Proclamation of Existence of Local Emergency and Resolution Requesting Presidential Declaration or Extension.

Agricultural Commissioner Wright discusses the damage to the crops and structural damage in the county. He estimates damage to at 2000 acres of alfalfa. He expects it to take a week or more to get a figure on the damage in the county.

No further business to come before the Board at this time, the meeting is adjourned to meet in regular session Tuesday, May 16, 1995 at 9:00 a.m.
